


General Setup Instructions


- Read entire setup instruction manual prior to unpacking parts and pieces.
- The setup instructions are created specifically for this configuration.
- Setup instructions are laid out sequentially in steps, including exploded views with detailed explanation for assembly.

Cleaning & Packing


- For Cleaning Metal, Plex, & Laminate Parts: Use a MILD NON-ABRASIVE cleanser and soft cloth/paper towel to clean all surfaces.
- Keep exhibit components away from heat and prolonged sun exposure. Heat and UV exposure will warp and fade components.
- Retain all provided Packing Materials. All provided packing materials are for ease of repacking & component protection.

Disassembly

- For loss prevention, tighten all set screws and locks during disassembly.




Part Identification - Numbering




Spline Connection




Base Plate & Extrusion Connection


Extrusion & Lock Connection





Side-by-Side Assembly

- 1) Frames: Place frames side-by-side with one higher than the other, then slide panel down to lock panels securely together.
- 2) Corner Connectors: Repeat Step 1 for installing corner connectors to frames.


Side-by-Side Disassembly

- 1) Pull pin lock outwards to disengage.
- 2) Pull frames upward and apart at the same time to detatch.

Note: Orientation of Corner




Stacking Assembly

- 1) Place one horizontal frame on top of the other, lining up the center grooves.
- 2) Turn stacking lock clockwise to tighten into place. Repeat for each lock.

Stacking Disassembly

- 1) Turn the stacking lock counter-clockwise to loosen.
- 2) The whole spring on the stacking lock should be in view to release each frame. The disengaged spring should release the stacking lock. If not, keep turning the stacking lock until it disengages.






The Perfect Fit

SEG Graphic Installation in 3 Steps

STEP 1: Attach Corners






Insert narrow side of silicone welt into the channel at corner **1**, with fabric to the outside.

Repeat for opposite corner **2**, then corner **3**, then corner **4**.


STEP 2: Attach Middle



Once corners are attached, press the middle of edge **1** into the channel. Then press middle of edge **2** into the channel on opposite side.

Repeat with edge 3 & 4.

STEP 3: Attach Sides



Once the middle of sides are attached, fully press the silicone welt into the channel, between center and corner at location 1. Repeat the process between center and corner at location 2.

Do the same for welt on opposite side, at locations **3** & **4**. Then repeat for locations **5** & **6** and **7** & **8**.

Once the welt is fully inserted on all sides, smooth out edges as needed for a perfect fit.






To remove the graphic from the frame, locate the fabric **pull tab**. Gently pull on the tab to remove the graphic.






Description Steps: Item Qty. 1) Assemble Gravitee panels & posts [1] through [11] together 30"w x 95"h Gravitee Panel w/ Velcro in numerical order as shown. Refer to the Gravitee Side-by-Side 30"w x 95"h Gravitee Panel w/ Velcro Assembly instructions in the general information pages. 95"h Gravitee Corner Post 28.5"w x 95"h Gravitee Panel w/ Door 2) Install Door to Panel [4]. 



Order #XXXXX Closet & Backwall Graphics

- 1) Apply SEG graphics to backwall assembly. Refer to the SEG Installation general information page.

 2) Attach Door graphic to Door Panel, using Velcro.

 3) Affix Infills to back of closet assembly, using Velcro.












- 1) Assemble horizontal [2] between verticals [1,3]. Repeat step, assembling horizontal [2A] between verticals [1A,3A].
- 2) Attach horizontal [4] to vertical [3]. Repeat step, attaching horizontal [4A] to vertical [3A].
- 3) Connect horizontal [5] between verticals [1,1A].
 4) Attach assembly to Gravitee Panel [11] by attaching horizontals [4,4A] to back side of panel. See Backwall Attachment detail.




- 1) Attach lower horizontals [6,6A] to underside of Cabinet. See Q914 to Cabinet Attachment detail.
- 2) Connect upper horizontals [7,7A] to top of Cabinet. See Q914 to Cabinet Attachment detail.
- 3) Connect vertical [8] to front of horizontals [6,7]. Repeat step, attaching vertical [8A] to front of horizontals [6A,7A].
- 4) Attach horizontals [6,7] to backwall vertical [1]; connect horizontals [6A,7A] to backwall vertical [1A], as shown.
- 5) Attach Counter Top to horizontals [7,7A] using screw caps. See Counter Top Attachment detail.















- 1) Attach Canopy to top of closet assembly. See Canopy Attachment detail.
- 2) Connect power cords to Puck Lights in canopy. See Puck Light Connection detail.
- 3) Attach Header Graphic to backwall verticals [1,1A]. See Header Attachment detail.
- 3) Install Monitor Mount to horizontal [5] using standoff barrels. See Monitor Mount Attachment detail.







Steps:

- 1) Attach lower horizontals [1,1A] to underside of Cabinet. See Q914 to Cabinet Attachment detail.
- 2) Connect upper horizontals [2,2A] to top of Cabinet. See Q914 to Cabinet Attachment detail.
- 3) Connect vertical [3] to front of horizontals [1,2]. Repeat step, attaching vertical [3A] to front of horizontals [1A,2A].
- 4) Attach vertical [4] to back of horizontals [1,2]. Repeat step, attaching vertical [4A] to back of horizontals [1A,2A].
- 5) Install Counter Top to horizontals [2,2A] using screw caps. See Counter Top Attachment detail.
- 6) Connect Graphic to front of verticals [3,3A]. See Graphic Attachment detail.
